Are you, or someone you know a victim of domestic violence?

VISIT YOUR NEAREST POLICE STATION

POLICE OFFICIALS HAVE A RESPONSIBILITY TO:

- > Provide information on how to apply for a Protection Order.
- > On receipt of an Interim or Final Protection Order, serve it without delay.
- > Arrest the respondent on contravention of the protection order when it is believed that they may cause harm to the complainant.
- > Seize any firearms or dangerous weapons that might be used or have been used to harm you.
- > Assist the complainant to obtain medical treatment and suitable shelter.

Should you not be happy or satisfied with the service provided by the police in response to a reported domestic violence incident, you can lay a formal complaint with the following offices:
