South Africa will host the second Russia-Africa Anti-Drug Dialogue conference at the **Durban International Conference Centre (ICC), KwaZulu-Natal.**

The Russian Federation will co-host the conference under the auspices of the African Union (AU) in pursuance of obligations in terms of the relevant United Nation (UN) Drug and Transnational Organised Crime Conventions, AU Plan of Action on Drug Control (2013-2017) and the BRICS resolution.

The conference is expected to attract participation by Ministers, Directors General and senior government officials from the member states of the AU, the Russian Federation and South Africa.

The purpose of the conference is to fight the unprecedented global illicit drug trade phenomenon that threatens security and stability, undermines sustainable economic development and adversely affects human health globally.
