VISIT YOUR NEAREST POLICE STATION POLICE OFFICIALS HAVE A RESPONSIBILITY TO :

- > Provide information on how to apply for a Protection Order.
- > On receipt of an Interim or Final Protection Order, serve it without delay.
- > Arrest the respondent on contravention of the protection order when it is believed that they may cause harm to the complainant.
- > Seize any firearms or dangerous weapons that might be used or have been used to harm you.
- > Assist the complainant to obtain medical treatment and suitable shelter.

Should you not be happy or satisfied with the service provided By the police in response to be reported domestic violence incident, you can lay a formal complaint with the following office:
